# Summer Science Blast Day Camps

## Drop-Off & Pickup



### Drop-off time:

- 8–9 a.m.

### Pickup time:

- 4–5 p.m.

You will be charged a late fee of \$1 per minute, per child, after 5 p.m.

### Monday only:

- Drop-off is located inside at the JPMorgan Chase Grand Lobby.
- All campers **must** be walked into the building by their guardian in the morning for check-in purposes.
- **Bring** Medical & Photo Release forms.
- For your child's safety, please remember to sign in your child with a Sci-Port Camp staff member.

### Tuesday-Friday:

- Drop-off and pickup are located in the Sci-Port circle drive. (See map.)
- Pickup in the right lane only. (Left lane is reserved for exiting traffic.)
- You must have an official Sci-Port pickup sign\* displayed on your dashboard for each camper you are picking up.

\*If you forget your sign(s), then you must park in one of the parking lots and come inside to the Pendulum area to sign out your child with a Sci-Port Camp staff member. Campers will only be released to a parent or guardian with photo ID, and who is also listed on the registration paperwork.
